



Position: Member of the CRWP Board of Directors

Background: The Cannon River Watershed Partnership (CRWP) Board of Directors (Board) provides organizational leadership, direction, and oversight to help carry out and achieve CRWP's core mission. The Board is legally, fiscally and ethically responsible for all activities of CRWP.

Qualifications: Be a current member of CRWP. Live or work in the Cannon River Watershed. Support the mission of CRWP.

Duties:

- 1) Carry out the responsibilities of the Board of Directors which includes:
 - a. Provide oversight of CRWP and the Executive Director to ensure that CRWP activities are conducted in an ethical and fiscal manner and in accordance with all applicable rules, statutes, and regulations.
 - b. Develop and provide direction to the Executive Director regarding the strategic growth and development of CRWP and CRWP programs and activities.
 - c. Provide oversight of the Executive Director and ensure that existing and proposed CRWP programs, grants, contracts, and activities align with and support the CRWP mission.
 - d. Ensure that financial, personnel, and other CRWP resources are used wisely to carry out the work of CRWP.
 - e. Review and approve CRWP annual budget, annual operation and work plan, annual fundraising plan, expenses, income, financial statements, minutes, reports, policies, procedures, and any CRWP personnel changes, position descriptions, and wages.
 - f. Evaluate the performance of the Executive Director.
 - g. Engage stakeholders to communicate the work and mission of CRWP to grow membership, encourage financial support of CRWP, and protect and improve the water quality and natural systems of the Cannon River Watershed.
 - h. Recruit and help develop the new members of the Board of Directors.
- 2) Attend and participate in Board meetings, general membership meetings, and CRWP events and activities.
- 3) Serve on at least one Board committee.
- 4) Serve a three (3) year term.
